To whom it may concern

Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 requires certain organisations to develop a slavery and human trafficking statement each year. Although Martin Lishman Ltd understands and fully recognises the importance of the Modern Slavery Act we do not qualify for having to comply with an annual statement of our Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy.
